

## **Bylaw 21/2002**

### **A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF ETTERS BEACH TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE MUNICIPALITY'S WATERWORKS SYSTEM.**

The Council of the Resort Village of Eppers Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

#### **SHORT TITLE**

1. This bylaw shall be cited as "The Water Management Bylaw".

#### **INTERPRETATION**

2. In this bylaw:
  - (a) "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Eppers Beach.

#### **APPLICATION**

3. (1) Any assessed owner may apply for either residential or commercial water service from the municipality by making arrangements with the Administrator, either in person or via telephone communication.

#### **RIGHT TO RATION**

4. The municipality shall have the right to limit the amount of water furnished to any customer, should circumstances seem to warrant such action.

#### **SALE OF WATER**


5. No person shall convey, sell, dispose of or give away or permit water to be carried or taken away or use it or supply it for the use or benefit of others.

#### **DISCONNECTION REQUESTS**

6. If a water consumer for any reason wishes to discontinue receiving water service, he/she shall apply to the Administrator who will attempt to ensure physical disconnection if possible.

PENALTY

7. Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw for which no other penalty is provided shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon summary conviction to penalties provided under the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
